DAY 1

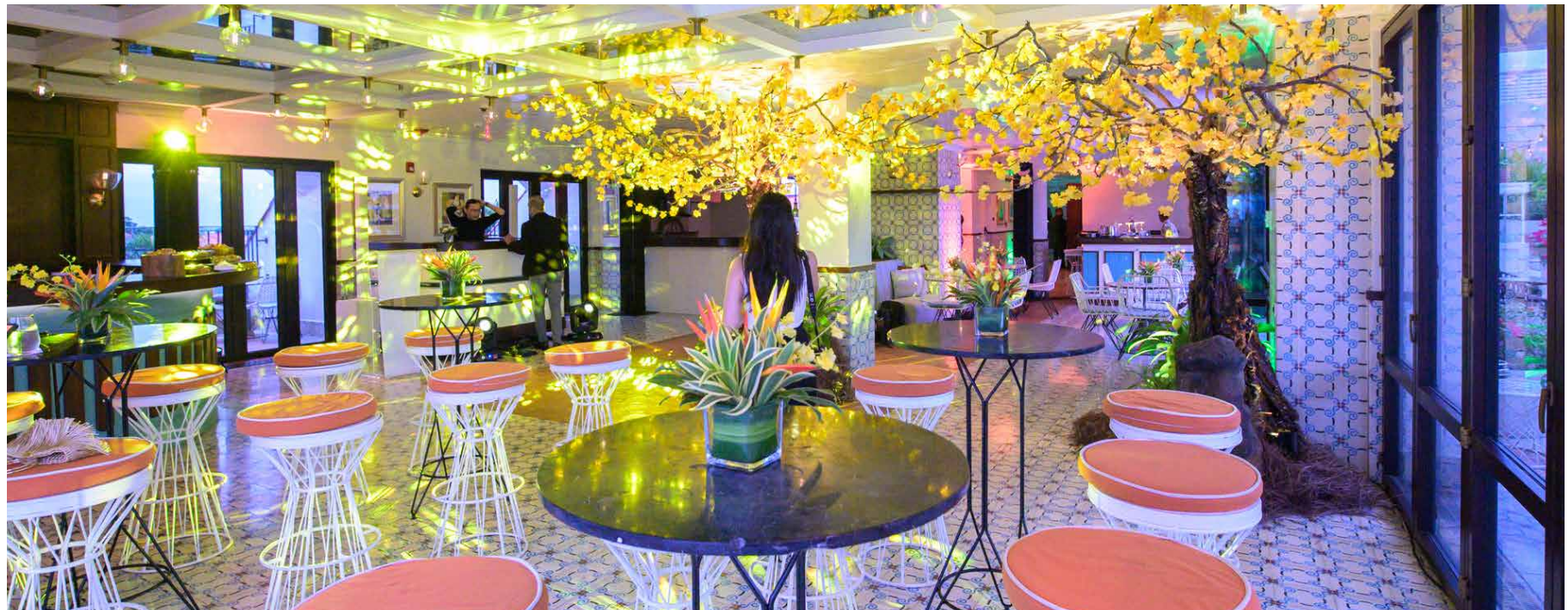
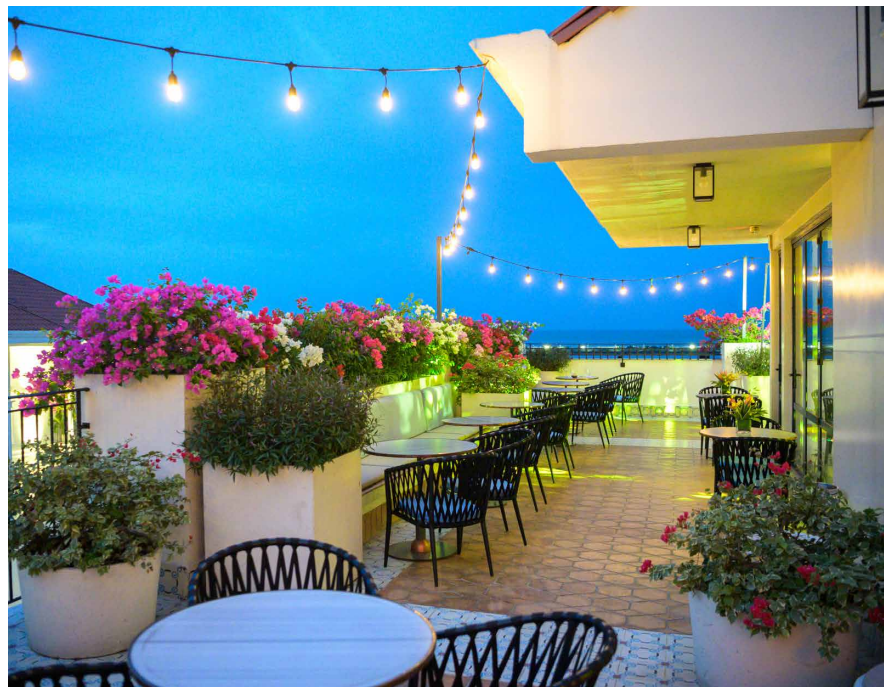
Welcome to Panama | Special Dinner: The sunset serenade

Welcome to Panama where a mix of nature, history, culture and tradition will captivate you. Upon arrival at the airport, you will have VIP assistance during the immigration processes and then our guide and driver staff will oversee taking you to your hotel in the financial center (in the order of arrival). Upon arrival you can have lunch at the hotel and leave your bags at reception while the time for room delivery approaches.

Later around 07:00 p.m. Our guide will be waiting for the entire group in the hotel lobby to give a brief introduction to the staff that will assist them and prepare them for the welcome dinner that will take place in one of the emblematic historical sites of Panama City: Casco Antiguo.

The transportation takes you on a journey of about 25 minutes to a certain point in Casco where due to the narrow colonial streets you will have to walk a little to get to where the elegance of Panama is gathered in one place, with spectacular views from a rooftop. Upon arrival you will be greeted by welcome drinks while the live music atmosphere entertains you, then a special dinner with Panamanian food will kick off your incentive trip.





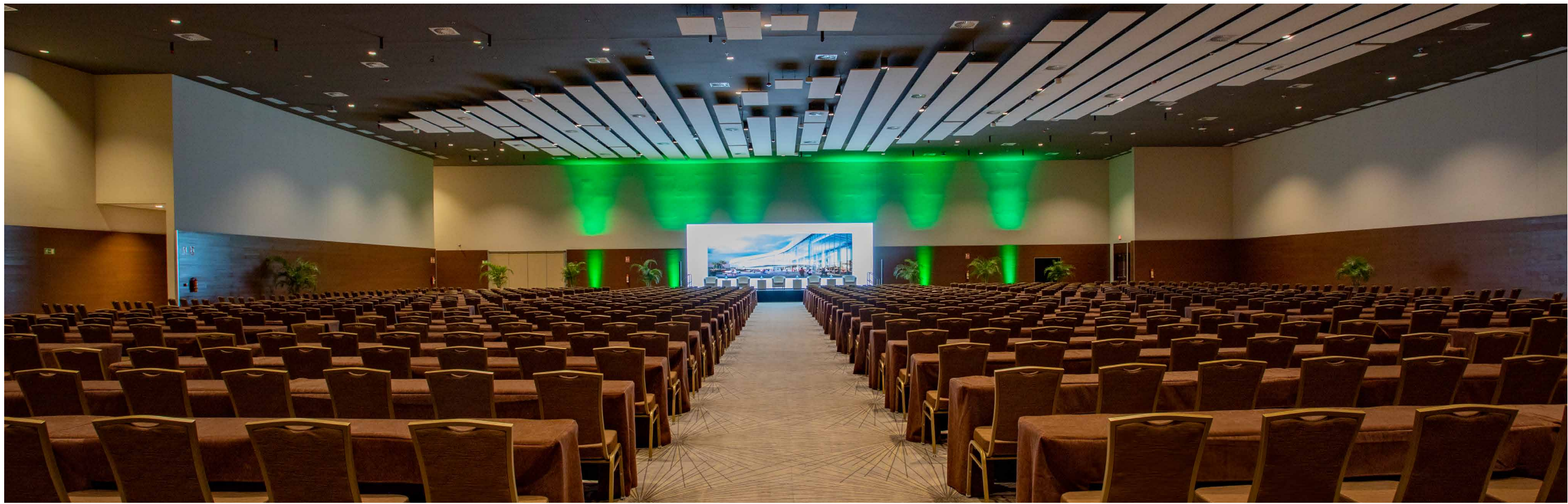
DAY 2

Connections and Culture Day in Panama: Meetings at the Panama Convention Center | Lunch at City of Knowledge and visit Behind the scenes of the Panama Canal.

Today you start the morning with a buffet breakfast at the hotel and then you meet the guide in the hotel lobby to be transferred to the Amador where the convention center is located, for about 30 minutes you tour the financial center and arrive at this impressive artificial causeway adjacent to the Panama Canal. Upon arrival at the Panama Convention Center, you will have a reception where the necessary materials for your meeting, event or convention will be delivered, and you will be directed to the room prepared for the event.

After the meetings and conferences, you will be able to enjoy a special moment when you are transferred to the City of Knowledge where a large part of Panama's sustainability efforts are concentrated and where you will be able to learn a little more about this beautiful place, here a picnic lunch is served at one of the flagship houses, enjoying soft background music (Panamanian) and tasting of different dishes that take us to the interior of the country.





Next you will have a special visit to the Miraflores visitor center where you will be able to see the operation of the canal up close: The impressive work of engineering that unites the continents and connects global trade. In this special visit you will be able to first handedly experience some important aspects not only of the history but also of the operation of these locks and, if you are a little lucky you will be able to see the transit of a ship. This visit culminates with a look at the history of the Panama Canal in the IMAX theatre.

In the afternoon you will be transferred to your hotel for a brief rest and change of clothes while waiting for today's dinner, which will take place in the surroundings of the financial center, at the award winning Azahar restaurant where a relaxed atmosphere of live violin music and saxophone will be available upon arrival. At the end of dinner, you will return to the hotel to rest.



DAY 3

Connections & Unique experiences day: Meetings, & Tasting Experience with team building workshop

Today the meetings and conferences continue, but before leaving for the Panama Convention Center you check out at the hotel so that dedicated transportation can take the luggage to the next destination, the Pacific Riviera or Playa Bonita.

After your morning work at the Panama Convention Center, we first move to the beach hotel to be able to check in and change clothes prior to the scheduled activities.

Then a cooking class and team building activities await you in Casco Antiguo. You will try some of the most emblematic flavors such as the well-known and special Geisha coffee brewed in certain areas in the west of Panama, and the chocolate and rum that is specially processed for the occasion. You will gain knowledge on the old town





during a team building activity where, divided into small groups, you will be able to put recently acquired knowledge into practice while doing a treasure hunt.

Today's lunch is included with the cooking class and the thematic dinner evening is centered around culture and history, highlighting the cultural diversity of Panama with presentations of different characters like Diablico Sucio, and show of Las Polleras. At the end of the evening, you will be transferred to your hotel at the Pacific Riviera or Playa Bonita.



DAY 4

Adventure, nature and Culture in Panama! Today you can enjoy Panama to the fullest.

Early departure from the hotel, your guide and driver will be waiting for you in the hotel lobby to take you to a day full of adventures, snacks and drinks will be available on today's journey. The first stop will be at the El Corozal station, where a classic train transfer awaits you so that you can cross the jungle parallel to the Panama Canal.

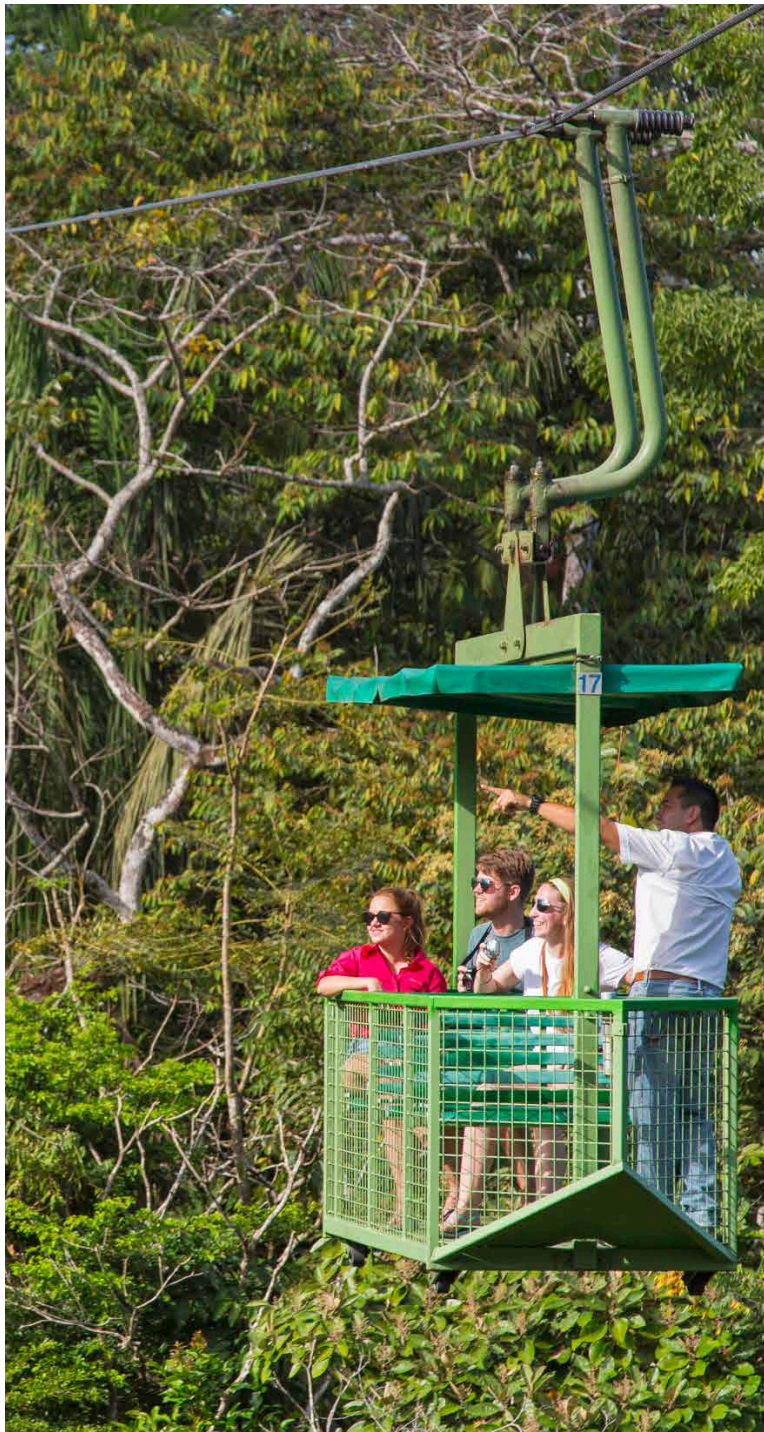
During the trip you can enjoy a breakfast prepared for you on board. Upon arrival in the Caribbean, at Colon station, you disembark the train and continue with your next adventure. You will be transferred to a special place where another teambuilding workshop awaits, together overcoming the obstacles and challenges that arise. At the end of the workshop, you head to Gamboa Rainforest Reserve located in the vicinity of Lake Gatun and the protected





reserve Soberania National Park. Here the group will be able to choose between different activities, Zip Line Adventure, Cable Car Jungle Experience, Jungle Hikes or a Boat Tour on Lake Gatun.

After the different groups finish the chosen activities, they meet to continue with a buffet lunch at the Gamboa restaurant and finish with a visit to the sloth sanctuary after lunch. As the afternoon ends, you will be transferred to the hotel to change clothes and rest a little before the special farewell beachfront dinner, where the Panamanian flora and the different cultures are highlighted. Here you will have the opportunity to see special shows (visiting tribes) Congo Dances and a little Caribbean flavor with live calypso music.

Departure Day

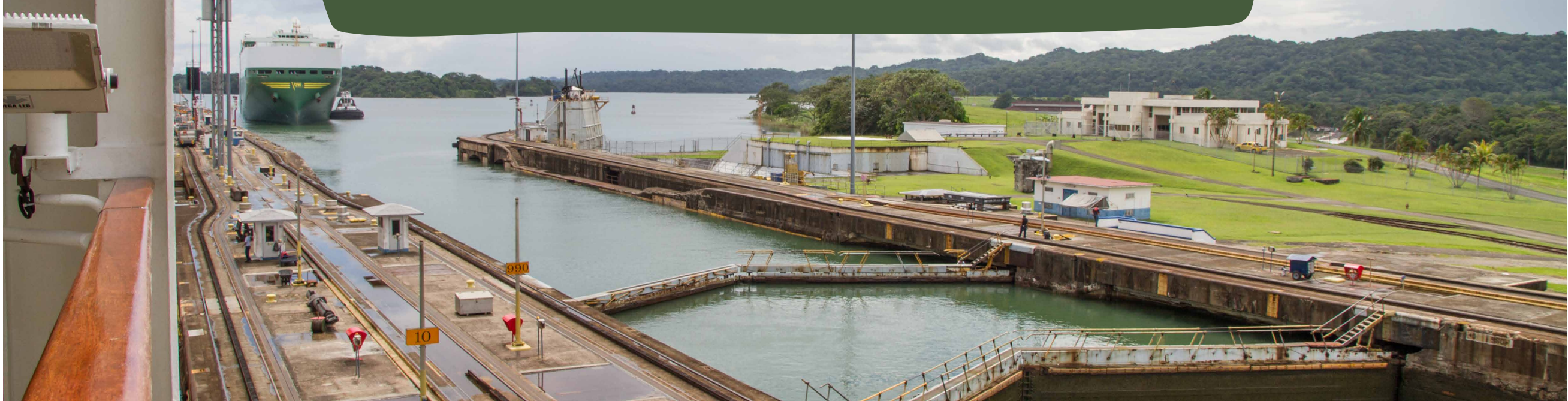

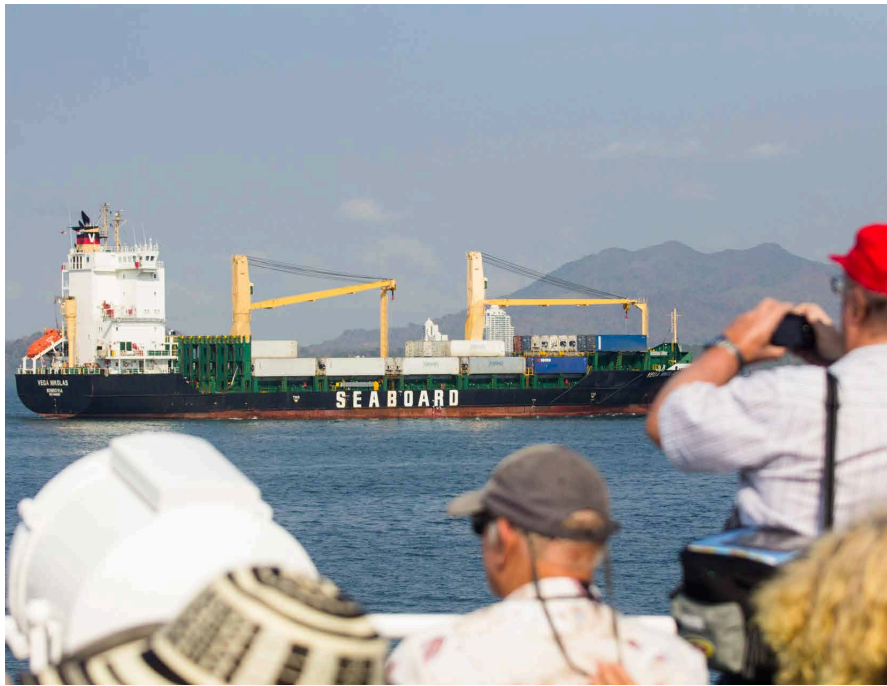

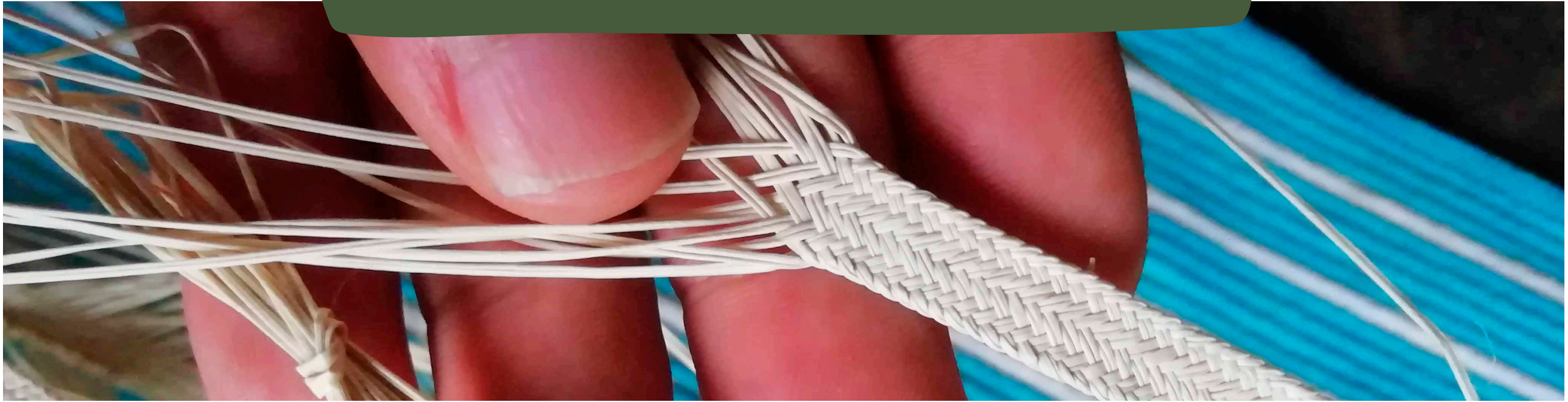
Panama Canal Cruise



The Panama Canal Partial Transit offers you the opportunity to cruise through Pedro Miguel Locks and Miraflores Locks (two of the three lock sets of the Panama Canal), on a 250-passenger ferry. Lunch on board is included.



Valle de Anton Culture Experience



This full day tour allows you to discover the surroundings of Valle de Anton, visiting communities, experiencing local culture, and enjoying authentic artistic expressions.

After breakfasting your guide and driver pick you up at your hotel for a transfer to a local community where you witness a demonstration on how to make fabric using vegetable fiber from a palm tree. Next you get insight into the elaboration of soapstone. Visit the extraction mine next to the river, and observe the figures created from this unique craft material. After lunch you will learn about the "Sombrero Pinta'o", the typical hat of Panama made by hand, a garment that best represents the identity of the Panamanian.

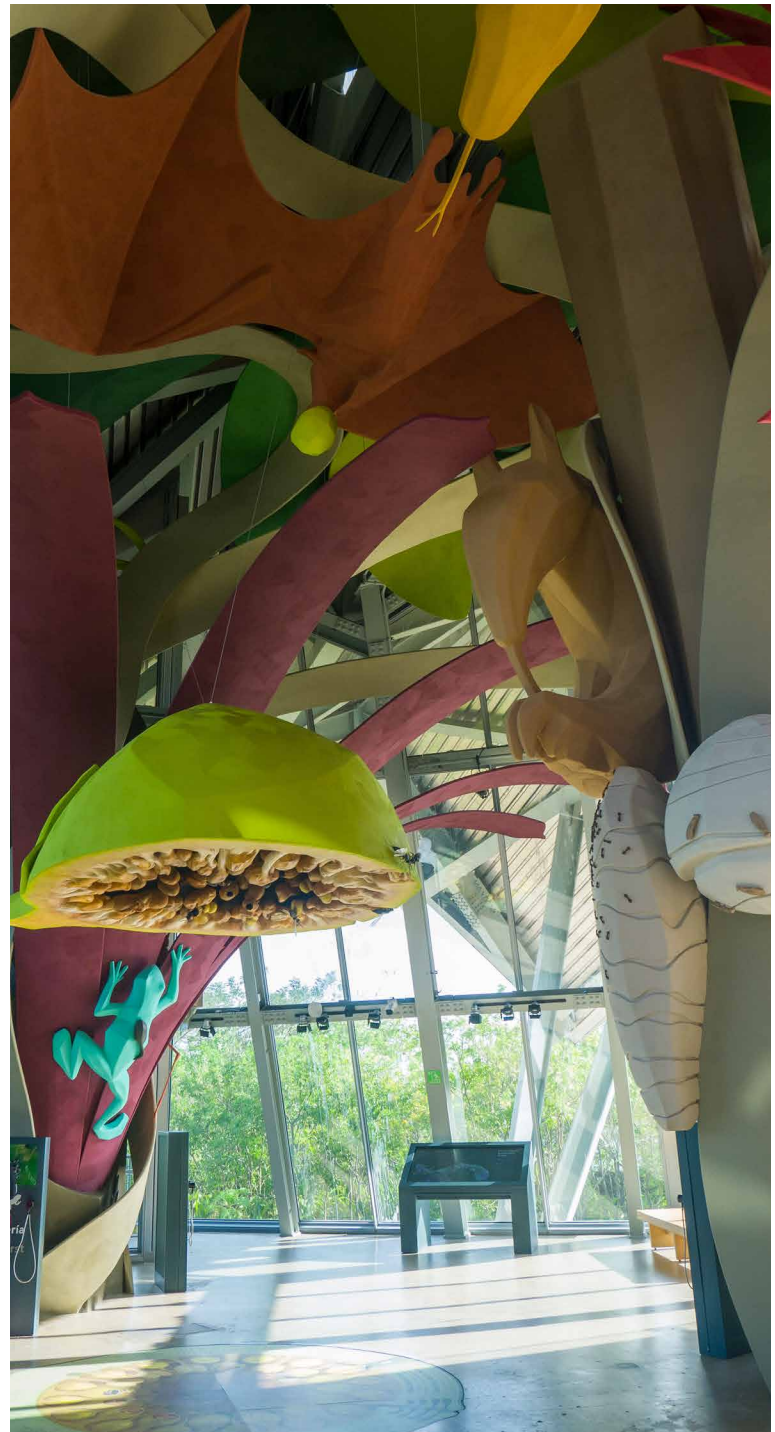
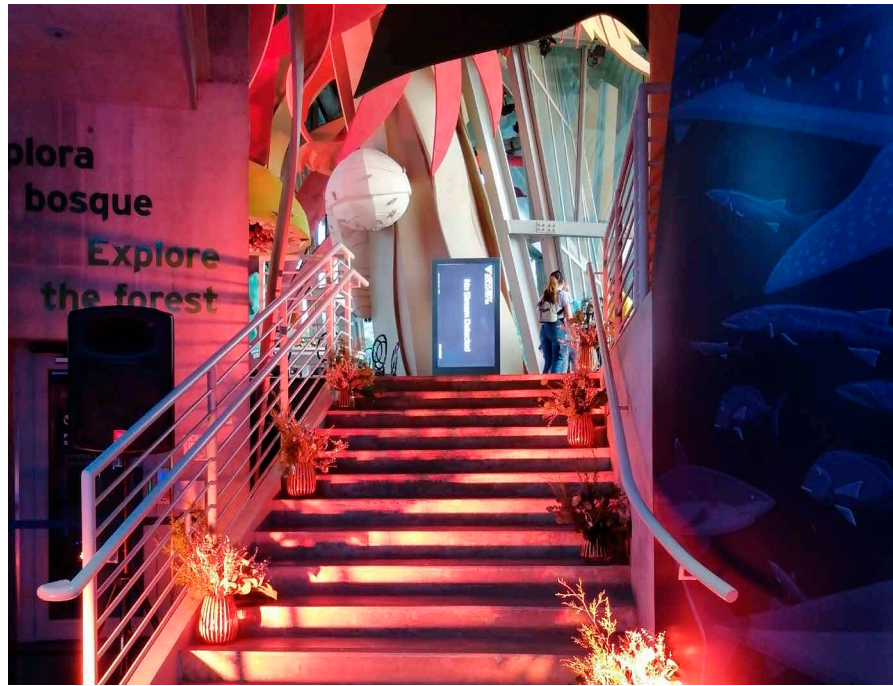


Special dinner in Panama's Biomuseo



To learn more about Panama's unique impact on the planet's biodiversity and the country's commitment to protecting the environment, you visit the Biomuseo. Famed architect Frank Gehry, the mastermind behind some of the world's most iconic buildings, such as the Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao and the Louis Vuitton Foundation in Paris, designed the striking, colorful building.

After you visit the indoor interactive exhibits, and before a special private dinner is served at this unique venue, you venture outdoors and explore Biodiversity Park. It surrounds the museum and includes green spaces such as the Lawn of Microdiversity and the Garden of Evolution. You can even see ships passing through the Canal and under the Bridge of the Americas.
